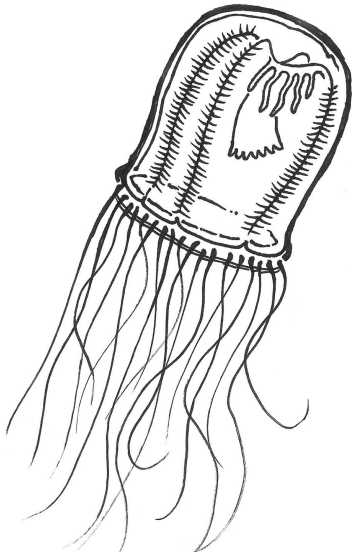


O'Neill Sea Odyssey Scientific Illustration Challenge
